



## TrailTrophy Flims-Laax 2019

### INFORMATIONS and PRE-BRIEFING

#### Please read this information carefully!!

We've summarised the most important informations concerning TrailTrophy Flims-Laax 2019 on the following two pages. Please read this carefully – further and detailed informations concerning the specific stages will be given right at the event area.

For registration at the race office please bring with you:

- a) **Signed declaration of non-liability (either in german or english language).**
- b) **20 Euro or 20 CHF deposit for transponder (handy please)**

**1. Registration/Race office:** open on Friday, 26 August, 9.00 am to 1.00 pm; in the “Rocks Resort” area, Via Murschetg 17, CH-7032 Laax (next to the ground station of cablecar Laax/ Crap sogn Gion).

**2. Opening/Briefing:** Friday, 26. August, 1.15 pm.

**3. Team name:** Please check that your team name is written correctly! Each member of the team must have the exactly same team name. Please send corrections before the event until Monday, 12 August. Last option for corrections is on Friday, 26 August, until 1:00 pm! While the TrailTrophy is in process, we can't accept any more corrections!

**4. Transponder:** You have to pay a deposit of 20 Euro or 20 CHF for the transponder, this will be given back on Sunday when returning the transponder. The transponder has to be fixed at your right wrist.

**4.1 Loss of transponder:** The transponder incl. holder is property of the company SPORTident, Arnstadt. The transponder has a material price of 50,- EUR and will be provided for a rental fee of 20,- EUR. This fee will be refunded upon return. In case of loss or damage this deposit will be retained and the remaining amount of 30,- EUR will be charged.

**5. Starting number:** has to be fixed at the handlebar.

**6. Helmet requirement:** Helmets are required at the WHOLE tracks, even on linking stages.

**7. Protection etc.:** The following protection is mandatory on ALL stages: Knee protection, long finger gloves. We recommend you to wear elbow protection and dorsal protection, for example special backpacks.

**8. Nightride:** Front and rear light are mandatory for the nightride. We're not responsible for false timing in case of using lamps without CE/EU-certificate. If you're not sure about this, use helmet mounting.

**9. Signalisation:** All tracks are signposted, of course. But don't expect barrier tape on each meter of the course/track. Keep your eyes open, both on the timed and linking stages.

**10. Starting list/slots:** The starting slots for the start are set by the race organisation. For the first Session No. 1 on Friday the results of Flims-Laax 2018 and Series ranking 2019 are basis for the starting list. All others will then start in a fixed order. The starting list will be posted on site from Friday morning. Keep to this order at the start! Who wants to start together with friends and is divided into different starting blocks: In this case the drivers with an earlier starting block have to change to a later starting block..

**11. Mountain railway/lift:** On Saturday and Sunday the participants will use the cablecars in Flims-Laax. The lift pass will be hand out with the start plate on Friday. There will be no replacement in case of losing it.

**12. Rules for the start:** At each start of the timed sections the „Gate Directors“ will make a call for the riders and take care for a minimum gap of about 15-20 sec. All participants have to stay/wait BEHIND the Gate Director!!

**13. Timing I:** The end of each timed session will be announced by a sign „Finish 50 m“ (if it's not visible in this distance) by finish banners and by barrier tape at both sides. Sometimes there will be a steward at the end of the timed session.

**14. Timing II:** The personal transponder saves all data of each session, the transponder is activated when you get it after your accreditation. It's mandatory to read out the transponder at the end of **each day!!** Therefore it is absolutely IMPORTANT to pass the TRAILTROPHY-tent near the FINISH ARCH at the Festplatz BEFORE and AFTER each session.

**15. Food service:** The following meals are included in your starting fee: Lunch on Saturday 17.08. Dinner on Saturday evening and a second breakfast by bike-components on Sunday, 18.08.
